GATHERING SAFETY & EMERGENCY BULLETIN

WELCOME TO THE 2023 POTAWATOMI GATHERING HOSTED BY NHBP!

Your safety is our primary concern, so we would like to share the following information with you:

- 1. If you **SEE SOMETHING**, **SAY SOMETHING**. Report any concerns to a **Red** or **Blue** shirted staff member or call 9-1-1 and request NHBP Tribal Police for assistance. After hours, please call 9-1-1 for assistance.
- 2. Listen to the public address system, camp announcements and stay tuned to AM Radio 1620 for emergency weather notifications.
- 3. Take prompt cover in the event of severe weather alerts and follow staff members' directions when seeking cover. For those camping, be familiar with the Government Center location and listen for directions to evacuate to the NHBP Government Center (see map on the back).
- 4. For medical assistance, please seek out medical staff in red shirts, NHBP staff member in blue shirts, go to the First Aid tent for assistance (see map on the back) or call 9-1-1.
- 5. For emergencies, dial 9-1-1 and request NHBP Tribal Police for assistance.
- 6. Keep your valuables, including children, wallets, purses, cell phones, etc., with you at all times.
- 7. Do not leave your children unattended. Unescorted children will be taken to the Tribal Police Tent for assistance.
- 8. During warm weather, stay hydrated to reduce the chance of heat stress. Beat the heat! Stay cool in air-conditioned or shaded areas when possible, and wear light-colored, lightweight, loose-fitting clothing. Stay hydrated by drinking water. Water will be available throughout NHBP Gathering events.
- 9. Pets are not permitted, nor are they to be left in cars while guests are attending.
- 10. Tribal Law prohibits weapons on Tribal premises.
