



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Do Tribal Members need to show their tribal ID to attend the Potawatomi Gathering?

A: Yes

Q: Can an attendee check-in for someone other than themselves?

A: No

Q: If a Tribal Member registered before the cutoff date and included their children as part of that registration, will all of the people in that family receive a welcome gift?

A: Yes, as long as they all have a Potawatomi Nation tribal ID, and they are within the first 3,000 registered by June 5.

Q: A Tribal Member registered before June 30th, included their spouse who is not a Tribal Member, does the Tribal Member's spouse receive a welcome gift?

A: No, but they will get a wristband. Welcome gifts are only for registered Tribal Members.

Q: A person would like to register, but is not a member of any Potawatomi Nation, can they register and/or attend?

A: No

Q: Is any part of the Gathering (7/24-7/29) open to the public?

A: No

Q: Is there a schedule of workshop dates, times?

A: Yes, it can be found on the Gathering Webpage.

Q: When can a Tribal Member sign up for a workshop?

A: 12:30 p.m. the day before the scheduled workshop at one of the registration areas located in FireKeepers Casino-Hotel Lobby or the Pine Creek Indian Reservation Registration Tent.

Q: *Can a Tribal Member sign up for all of the workshops they want to attend at the same time?*

A: No. You can only sign up for one workshop at a time. In order to sign up for more, you will be asked to go to the back of the line.

Q: *Can a Tribal Member bring their children along with themselves to the workshop that they signed up for?*

A: Workshops are not open to youth under the age of 13.

Q: *Although there are activities set up for youth and children, is there an age requirement for participating in workshops designed for adults?*

A: 13 years and older.

Q: *Will food be provided?*

A: Food vendors will be on-site throughout week of the Gathering. Registered Tribal Members and staff of invited tribal organizations will receive \$25/day in Mijem Bucks to use from Wednesday – Saturday in various locations.

There will also be food provided at the various conferences occurring throughout the week.

A Traditional Meal is scheduled on Saturday beginning at 4 p.m.

Q: *Will there be camping available?*

Q: *Will there be a shuttle service available?*
